Sermon Notes

- Learn how to act on the **INFORMATION** God has given to you.
- The Word of God should be your *ultimate* **EDUCATION**.
- **SATURATION** occurs when you choose to make everything you say, hear, remember and do be to the glory of God.
- **REVELATION** opens you up to things you couldn't see before.
- God exists right outside your ability. When you get there, if you're living in God's will, you should be in **EXPECTATION** of His ever-present help.
- Die to yourself, so you can rise again and experience the **MANIFESTATION** of what God has planned for your life.

Manifestation

Entry Word: *manifest*

Function: *verb*

Text: *something that manifests or reveals*

Related Words materialization, expression, demonstration, etc.

Phrases a clear appearance, an indication of the existence or presence of some person or a thing

MANIFESTATION (the Promise)

John 14:21-24 (New King James Version)

21 "He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him." **22** Judas (not Iscariot) said to Him, "Lord, how is it that You will manifest Yourself to us, and not the world?"

23 Jesus answered and said to him, "If anyone loves Me, he will keep My word; and My Father will love him, and We will come to him and make Our home with him.

24 "He who does not love Me does not keep My words; and the word which you hear is not Mine but the Father's who sent Me.

2 Corinthians 4:2-6 (New King James Version)

2 But we have renounced the hidden things of shame, not walking in craftiness nor handling the word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

3 But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, **4** whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them. **5** For we do not preach ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your bondservants for Jesus' sake. **6** For it is God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

LIFE MANIFESTED

1 John 1:1-4 (Amplified)

1 [WE ARE writing] about the Word of Life [in] Him Who existed from the beginning, Whom we have heard, Whom we have seen with our [own] eyes, Whom we have gazed upon [for ourselves] and have touched with our [own] hands. **2** And the Life [an aspect of His being] was revealed (made manifest, demonstrated), and we saw [as eyewitnesses] and are testifying to and declare to you the Life, the eternal Life [in Him] Who already existed with the Father and Who [actually] was made visible (was revealed) to us [His followers]. **3** What we have seen and [ourselves] heard, we are also telling you, so that you too may realize and enjoy fellowship as partners and partakers with us. And [this] fellowship that we have [which is a distinguishing mark of Christians] is with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ (the Messiah). **4** And we are now writing these things to you so that our joy [in seeing you included] may be full [and your joy may be complete].
